TIPS AND TRICKS: OCLC SEARCHING

1. Use both OCLC PASSPORT and WORLDCAT PASSPORT

try all types of searches 3,2,2,1 title 4,4 author title 4,3,1 author =4,3,1 Corporate author Scan ti Sudocs number LC card number ISBN or ISSN numbers

WORLDCAT

use Keyword searches in both author and title

- 2. Be sure you look for a title page and use that info if it varies from the cover or spine
- 3. Search cover and spine info
- 4. Try the running title if there is one
- 5. Search the LC card #, available in many of the old Monthly catalog records
- 6. See the 1909 Checklist for notes and clues (access by SuDocs number)
- 7. See Androit's Guide to U.S. Government Publications for notes and clues

8. See 770, 772, 773, 775, 780, 785, 787 MARC fields for other OCLC records that might give you a clue. These fields also sometimes contain the LC card #.

- 9. Have several people search and search several different times.
- 10. Try limiting by date, format, etc.
- 11. Scour OCLC searching guides for hints
- 12. Watch out for stop words
- 13. Look for CIP in the document
- 14. Try everything!
